The Board of Veterans' Appeals (Board) was established in 1933 and operates by authority of, and functions pursuant to, Chapter 71 of Title 38, USC. The Board consists of a Chairman, Vice Chairman, Principal Deputy Vice Chairman, and sufficient Veterans Law Judges (VLJs), staff counsel, and other administrative and clerical staff to conduct hearings and decide appeals in a proper and timely manner.
