

# How to select a Fortify Visual Studio IDE Plugin


## Question

There are several options for installing the Fortify Visual Studio plugin. Which one should I select?

## Answer

Plugins are selected as part of the Fortify installation process. If a plugin was not installed or was incorrectly installed, the installation process may be rerun to correct the issue.

From the select components page of the installation, select the "Plugins" check box. Then select the "Complete" Visual Studio plugin for the version or versions of Visual Studio that you have installed. For example, if you have Visual Studio 2012 installed, select the "Visual Studio 2012 Complete" plugin. Do **not** select the "Scan" or "Remediation" plugins. If you select these in addition to the complete plugin, the plugins will not work correctly.



If you select more than one of the plugins, you need to run the SCA installer again, deselect the ones which you have installed and select only the "Visual Studio 2012 Complete" plugin.
