

Fortify 16.10 Does Not Support .NET Version 4.6

The purpose of this announcement is to share with the VA developer and contractor community that the current version of HPE Fortify does not support .NET version 4.6:

| *.NET 4.6 is not yet supported (not the .NET Core), even in the latest version, 16.10.*

HPE Fortify must still be used to scan .NET 4.6 projects, however version 4.6-specific features may result in errors reported by Fortify. Currently, the following issue has been identified when scanning .NET 4.6 projects:

| *[1236] Failed to translate the following aspx files*

If VA developers are using .NET 4.6 and encounter issues related to this version of .NET they should account for these errors as follows:

- If the error **is** described in this blog posting: VA developers should account for this scan error by including a readme file that indicates .NET 4.6 is being used and references this blog posting, in addition to normal submission materials, when submitting an application to the VA Software Assurance Program Office to perform an A&A-time code review validation. The information will then be taken into consideration so that the scan error is not counted against the application.
- If the error **is not** described in this blog posting: Please contact Fortify technical support (fortifytechsupport@hpe.com) about the error and get confirmation that the issue is due to lack of support for .NET 4.6. Include this communication along with the submission materials, when submitting an application to the VA Software Assurance Program Office to perform an A&A-time code review validation. The information will then be taken into consideration so that the scan error is not counted against the application.
